



## Mark Scott Swinson

October 12, 1955 - June 14, 2019

Mark Scott Swinson, a resident of Murrieta, California for the past 19 years, passed away unexpectedly on June 14, 2019 after suffering a heart attack. He was 63.

Mark was born on October 12, 1955 in Sycamore, Illinois to Lloyd and Gertrude (Robinson) Swinson, one of seven siblings. He married Lita (Olmstead) and they lived in Genoa, Illinois with their son Scott until 1983 when they moved to Florida. Mark is survived by his wife of 45 years, Lita, his son Scott (Milay) Swinson, grandchildren Sidney VanEman, Christian Canotal, and Jace Swinson, two brothers Craig Swinson and Larry (Donna) Swinson, two sisters Dilene (Jerry) Simmons, and Mary (Bill) Fraedrich, and numerous nieces and nephews, as well as his beloved Labrador Riley, who never left Mark's side. He was preceded in death by his parents, three brothers, Richard, Barry and Brian Swinson, and one sister, Debra Swinson.
